## A PHILADELPHIA HOLIDAY DANCE MUSICAL TRADITION AND COVID-19 VACCINE CLINIC

Carols in Color is based on "Black Nativity" by Langston Hughes, and a 1960s musical adaptation by Vinette Carrol. The holiday tradition was first born in 1992 when director, choreographer, vocal coach, and arranger Leon Evans produced the first Carols in Color.

Today, the dance and musical treasure continues under the artistic direction of Shawn-Lamere Williams, the executive direction of Sheila A. Ward, and the musical direction of Omar-Frederick Pratt. Carols in Color features many of Philadelphia's most renowned vocalists and the dance company founded by Leon Evans, Eleone Dance Theatre.
