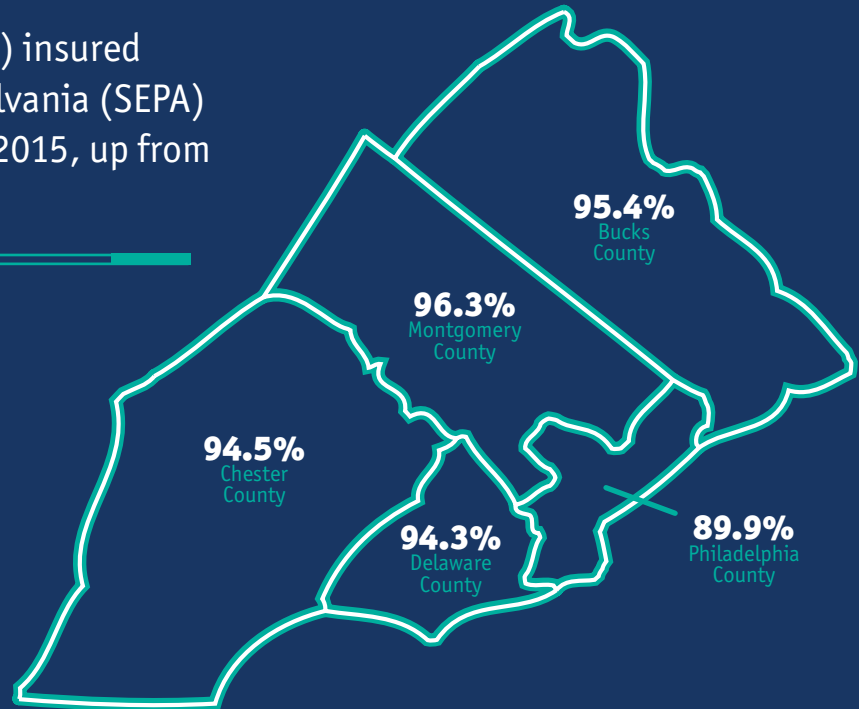




HOUSEHOLD HEALTH SURVEY

COUNTY-WIDE DATA RELEASE

Percentage of adults (18-64) insured in the Southeastern Pennsylvania (SEPA) region increased to 93% in 2015, up from 87.6% in 2012.



Of the approximate 521,000 adults (ages 18-64) who looked into buying insurance through healthcare.gov, 21% used the site to purchase insurance:

Philadelphia County	39.3%
Delaware County	36.6%
Chester County	37.5%
Bucks County	34.8%
Montgomery County	33.4%



Hispanics and Blacks are more likely to be uninsured
21.4% of Hispanic adults are uninsured, followed by Black adults where 11% are uninsured.

Hispanics and Blacks are more likely not to have prescription medical coverage

35.1% of Hispanics do not have prescription medical coverage followed by 23.9% of Black respondents.



Males are more likely to be uninsured
10.7% of males are uninsured compared to 6.7% of females.

Males are more likely not to see a dentist in the past year
36.3% of males have not seen a dentist compared to 28.5% of females.
