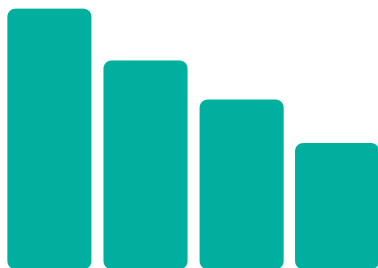
2015 • **HOUSEHOLD HEALTH SURVEY

At the core of CHDB is the Southeastern Pennsylvania Household Health Survey, the largest regional household health survey in the country. Here's a snapshot of what the 2015 survey captured from 10,000 households across Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties:


