Our approach to treatment for individuals with **substance use disorder, including opioid use disorder**, is grounded in science and the understanding that the disorder is a chronic, medical condition from which **recovery and wellness are possible**.



## PHMC Center of Excellence for Opioid Use Disorder Treatment

The Center of Excellence is a model of coordinated care offered through a patient centered medical home to help individuals access a variety of services to support recovery. Patients are also referred to other levels of care within PHMC's network of programs and to external resources. The Center of Excellence operates in three of PHMC's health centers in Philadelphia.

### Service Highlights:

- Assessments and psychiatric evaluations
- Medication Assisted Treatment (same-day inductions available)
- On-site pharmacy
- Integrated behavioral health
- Access to primary care, prevention services, care management, behavioral health services
- Medication management and peer specialist support

**Medication Options:** Buprenorphine, Vivitrol, methadone referrals, nicotine replacement medications

**Eligibility:** Adults 18 years or older with an opioid use disorder in need of support and/or treatment referral.

**Eligibility:** Adults 18 years of age or older. Must be Philadelphia resident on Medicaid or Medicaid-eligible.
